Abstract Submission Guidelines

Important Dates:

- Abstract submission opens
1st Nov 2018
- Abstract submission deadline
30th Nov, 2018
- Decision on submitted abstract
2nd Dec, 2018
- Scientific Schedule by
4th Dec, 2018

How to Submit:

Please submit abstract on the following email id: scientific.ies2018@gmail.com

- The title of the abstract should be concise and should **not exceed 15 words**. The complete title should be capitalized and should not contain abbreviations.
- Abstracts should not exceed 200 words and have font style: Times New Roman, font size: 12 , alignment: justified with spacing of 1.5 between the lines

Important Information:

- The total duration of the oral presentation should not **exceed 08 minutes**. The time assigned for discussion post presentation is 2 minutes. The stipulated time must be **STRICTLY** adhered to.
- For e- posters the presenters should be present at the designated date and time and will be allocated 3 minutes time for Q&A
- Submission of abstract carries with it an obligation to present the accepted paper in person without any change in scientific content during the allotted time in the convention
- **Registration for the conference is mandatory before submission of the abstract**

- **For certificates of scientific presentation to be awarded to co-authors they should be registered for the conference.**
- There can be 2 authors per paper, and 3 authors for e-posters, however only one presenter will be allowed to present.
- Laptop will be provided for presentation, presenter has to bring his/her presentation in pendrive.

A delegate has a choice to make either a

- Oral presentation
- E- Poster presentation

However the delegate can make only **ONE** presentation in each category.

All presentations should be submitted under following types

- Original Research
- Clinical Case Report/ Case Series
- Review

The abstract for **original research** should be structured and comprise of

- Title
- Introduction
- Material & Methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- Clinical relevance

The abstract for **case report/case series** should comprise of

- Introduction
- Brief description of case
- Brief description of intervention

- Conclusion

The abstract for **review presentations**

The choice of topic for the review presentation should be such that it benefits the scientific community in terms of gain in assimilated knowledge. Presentation of data of any systematic reviews conducted would be encouraged. The abstract for such presentations could be non structured, but should give the back ground information, the reason for conducting the review and the outcome of the exercise should be highlighted

GUIDELINES FOR E-POSTER PRESENTATION

1. These posters are to be submitted in .ppt or . pptx format using Microsoft 2007 PowerPoint or later version only.
2. Maximum size of the file should not exceeded 25MB.
3. E-posters once submitted cannot be modified or changed.
4. Any kind of animations will not be allowed.
5. The scientific committee will review all abstracts that have been submitted on time and in the correct format.

NOTE

- *All the powerpoint presentations and word documents should be in MS Office 2007 compatible mode.*
- *All the presenters must mention their email ID and Contact Numbers for further communication.*
 - The authors of abstract accepted/rejected for presentation will receive via email.
- **Acceptance of abstract is subject to the decision of the scientific committee which would be final and binding.**
